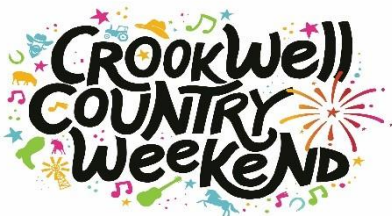

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- All participants agree to indemnify Upper Lachlan Shire Council against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may result in any injury or other loss sustained by you/anyone participating in the 2023 Crookwell Country Weekend Street Parade.
- All participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless Upper Lachlan Shire Council in the event of any claim for loss, damage or otherwise by any person.
- Upper Lachlan Shire Council does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss for your business/property or participants.
- Participants are to ensure displays are firmly secured in the event of wind/inclement weather.

PARADE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All participants are responsible for their own personal safety and security. Personal belongings must be in a secure place. All parade entrants should carry water and sun protection.
2. All vehicles must be roadworthy, registered with compliant greenslips or appropriate permit. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of public and every person travelling on or in the vehicle.
3. All entries must continue in a forward motion through the parade route. Entries must not stop or cause delay. The instructions of Upper Lachlan Shire Council, SES Traffic Controllers and NSW Police must be obeyed. Parade participants must adhere to the parade route and keep within parade time frames. Failure to comply with instructions by officials could result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future parades.
4. Entries must proceed in the order designated by the Parade organiser.
5. Participants are reminded that this event takes place in a designated Alcohol Free Zone and alcohol is not permitted.
6. Children participating in parade must be accompanied and under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times.
7. Photographs/film may be taken and used by the Crookwell Country Weekend, the Upper Lachlan Shire Council, the media and others to publicly promote the events.
8. No animals are to participate in the 2023 parade unless safely secured on a float/vehicle.
9. Entrants are not permitted to distribute or throw giveaways directly from the vehicle/float. Entrants may hand out giveaways from person to person on foot while on the parade route.
10. The use of fireworks, crackers, sparklers or other pyrotechnics, sirens or water pistols at any time during marshalling or the parade is discouraged (with the exception of emergency vehicles).
11. The Crookwell Country Weekend and Upper Lachlan Shire Council reserves the right to exclude any group, individual or organisation from participating in the parade.
12. Participants may be breathalysed. Drivers must test zero blood alcohol content
13. All vehicles should be set up so as to ensure the safety of their passengers. All vehicles nominated supervisors should ensure the care and safety of their passengers by making certain that they have been adequately briefed in relation to safety and by ensuring that all materials used are effectively secured. The nominated supervisor is to sign the terms and conditions form stating they are aware of the terms and conditions for parade entry.
14. All drivers must be appropriately licensed for the type of vehicle being driven including motorcyclists.
15. All passengers (including children and babies) must be restrained when riding in a vehicle.



16. While entrants are restricted to a <10km/h speed limit, they are also required to maintain a constant speed and not come to a stop or create excessive space between their float and the entry in front. NO vehicles are to go in a full circle around the roundabout. All vehicles are to go straight through the round about and continue down Goulburn Street.

17. You must abide by Assembly & Disembarkation Instructions as it is illegal to allow anyone to ride on the back of a float whilst travelling outside the parade areas, this includes to and from the assembly & disembarkation point. NSW Police fines apply.

- **Muster Place:** Denison Street with lead vehicles at corner of Colyer Street trailing back to Roberts Street. The Parade will run down Goulburn Street from the Colyer Street end.
- **Muster Time:** 9am for a 10am parade start
- **Parade order:** Each vehicle will be allocated a number and the parade will be marshalled to place vehicles in the right order before the parade.
- **Prize:** There is a \$1,000 prize for the entrant judged as best.
